

## **Short Description**

Caution Sign - Steep Stairs

## **Description**

- Used to warn staff or visitors that the stairs ahead are steep and may pose a risk of injury/harm if caution is not taken.
- Commonly found on multi-level facilities or purpose-built scaffolds with stairs built steep to reduce space.
- Features black wording, symbol and border over a bright yellow background.
- Available in a wide range of AS1319 compliant sizes and materials to suit any requirement.
- Caution signs should be placed either in advance of, next to and/or on the relevant hazard.
- Positioning and sizing of this Caution sign must comply with Australian Standard AS 1319-1994.
- Please note, Australian Standard AS 1319 states that caution sign cannot be used to warn of a hazard that is likely to be life-threatening (we recommend using a danger sign instead).
