Environmental Hazard Hazchem Sign

Description

Indicate the storage and containment of environmentally hazardous goods within a facility or container.

- Represents chemical substances that may pose a significant threat to the environment if inadequately handled and disposed of.
- Examples: Carcinogens, Anthrax, and Asbestos.
- Recognisable by a white background with a black and white symbol to indicate the eco-hazard.
- Complies to Australian Standard AS1216-2006.
- During an emergency situation, this sign will allow emergency services to identify any chemicals present.
- It is important as a business to correctly label all hazardous chemicals using the appropriate Hazchem Signage.
- Available in a large range of materials and sizes to suit any application.
